Frequently Asked Questions

Who are we?

→ Adrenaline is OTHS's premier a cappella ensemble. Music is performed entirely with voices, and repertoire includes popular music, unlike the traditional curricular choirs.

What's the time commitment?

- → Rehearsals will generally take place weekly on **Tuesdays from 6:30 8pm**
 - Additional rehearsals at the director's discretion but will be given 2 weeks notice
- Required events include the winter concert, December 21st caroling, finale concert, community outreach events, and at least 1 fundraiser a year.

How do I audition?

- → Tuesday, **September 12th 3:30-7:30pm** ⓐ the Milburn Choir Room
 - Sign up for an audition slot via sign up genius link: https://www.signupgenius.com/go/10C0F4CA8Ag2AA1FEC07-adrenaline1
 - ◆ Other audition slots available via email, if you can't make this date!
- → Read, fill out, & sign this audition packet
- → Prepare 60 seconds of a song of your choice (a cappella, no accompaniment/track)
 - The song should show off your vocal capabilities in a pop context.
 - Do not prepare an art song or aria.
 - Do prepare a pop or poppy musical theatre song.
- → Show up to your audition: The audition may also include some basic sight reading, music questions and tonal memory exercises.

Do I have to be in choir to be in Adrenaline?

→ No. All OTHS students are permitted to audition

Policies

Attendance

- → Your attendance & participation in rehearsals & performances is essential to the success of the whole group. Therefore, you are allowed ONLY 3 unexcused absences. If you have 4, you will be replaced.
 - Excused absences include the following: death in the family or illness /excused absence from school, or other conflicting <u>school</u> activity.
 - If you are involved in a sport or other school-related activity and have a conflict with a required event, you must notify the director in writing (email) <u>AT LEAST</u> ONE WEEK IN ADVANCE of the conflict so the director and the sponsor can work out a solution.
 - Failure to communicate such absences with at least 1 week's notice in writing (email) will result in an unexcused absence.
- → Work schedules, doctor/dentist/orthodontist/eye appointments, and other non-emergency scheduling need to be made around rehearsals. We only rehearse once a week so I expect you to be here, focused, and engaged at rehearsal.
- → Emergencies happen. This I understand. What is an emergency you may ask? Death in the family, car accident, and the like. See below for things that are NOT emergencies:
 - Work, Getting stuck in traffic, Tickets to some other event on the day and time you have rehearsal, Going to your siblings' games, Your birthday, Going out to dinner, etc.
- → Early = on time. On time = late. Late = unacceptable. 3 Tardies count as 1 unexcused absence.

Policies Continued

Conduct

- → You are a student first. Then a member of this group. You must prioritize your academics in order to stay in this ensemble.
 - Students who are not passing 5 classes will be considered ineligible, according to a weekly ineligibility report. Ineligible students may not participate in extra-curricular activities. Ineligibility is NOT an excused absence.
- → All participants must abide by the rules & regulations outlined in the 2023-2024 Activities Handbook and the Student Handbook.
- → Additionally, all members are responsible for reading the OTHS Choir Handbook and abiding by all policies and procedures listed there.



- → Adrenaline is a part of the OTHS Choir program and as such, all participants are responsible for upholding the highest standards of musical excellence as well as moral and personal excellence. Failure to uphold this standard may result in a conference with the student, parent conference, suspension or removal from the group at the director's discretion.
- → Students will be responsible for providing their own clothing for concerts & performances. It will likely be a variation of concert black.
